As most know, Michael Boney is the Cantor of Music for St. Michael's Episcopal Cathedral. He is preparing a concert tour and we will benefit with a preview of some of the works. Sylvia Hunt, involved for many years with the College of Idaho, is also Executive Director for Caldwell Fine Arts and "the driving force behind arts education programs in [Caldwell] area schools. Appropriate Organ Music in LDS Worship Services

"The hymns are the basic music for worship services and are standard for all congregational singing. In addition, other appropriate selections may be used for prelude and postlude music..."

"Quiet prelude and postlude music creates an atmosphere of worship that invites the Spirit into Church meetings. The organist usually plays hymns and other appropriate music for five to ten minutes before and after a meeting." (Handbook 2,14.4. 2&3)

ORGAN PRELUDE AND POSTLUDE MUSIC

ORGAN CHAINS Arranged by Brent Jorgensen - Six Volumes plus CHRISTMAS CHAINS - for easy organ - very accessible for a pianist to play on the organ.

NINE HYMN STUDIES Arranged by D. Kim Croft - for easy organ - very nice three part pieces.

QUIET PIECES FOR ORGAN Book One—Compiled and Edited by Darwin Wolford.

HYMN PRELUDES FOR THE ORGAN in Ten Volumes (Volume 10 is for Christmas) by Robert Manookin - for intermediate organ.

POSTLUDES Arranged by James C. Kasen - Three Volumes plus *CHRISTMAS POSTLUDES* – for intermediate organ - not just for postludes - many make nice preludes.
